ORDINANCE NO. 23-006

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COPPER CANYON, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING CHAPTER 1 ‘GENERAL PROVISIONS’, ARTICLE 1.04 ‘BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS’, DIVISION 2 ‘PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION’, SECTION 1.04.031 ‘CREATED; COMPOSITION’, TO AMEND SUBSECTION (A) TO PROVIDE FOR WAIVER OF THE HOLDING OF AN ADDITIONAL APPOINTED POSITION; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR SAID ORDINANCE TO TAKE EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Copper Canyon, Texas (“Town Council”), desires to amend their Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COPPER CANYON, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Copper Canyon, Texas, be and in the same is hereby amending Chapter 1, “General Provisions”, Article 1.04 “Boards and Commissions”, Division 2 “Planning and Zoning Commission”, Section 1.04.031 “Created; composition’ which shall read as follows:

“CHAPTER 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

ARTICLE 1.04. BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

Division 1. Generally

....

Division 2. Planning and Zoning Commission

§ 1.04.031 Created; composition.

- (a) There is hereby created a planning and zoning commission consisting of five (5) members who shall be residents of the town and registered voters thereof. No member of the planning and zoning commission may hold a state, federal, county or any elected office of any water or special utility district, or any voting entity affecting the town. Town Council may waive the prohibition of holding an additional appointed position as stated herein by a vote of a seventy-five percent majority.

SECTION 2. That all provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Copper Canyon, Texas, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby, repealed, and all other provisions not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any word, phrase, paragraph, section or phrase of this ordinance or of the Code of Ordinances, as amended hereby, be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, and shall not affect the validity of the Code of Ordinances as a whole.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law and charter in such cases provide.
